











Castle Garden GONE!!!

There isn't a separate "Castle Garden immigration website" anymore, as the former site's records are now hosted for free on FamilySearch.org, specifically within the New York Passenger Lists (1820-1891) database. You can also find information about this era of immigration, America's first official processing center, at the National Park Service's Castle Garden Emigrant Depot page and the National Archives website for the Castle Garden Immigration Center Collection.



 Scandinavia, and Other European Countries, ca. 1820 ca. 1912
- German, French, and Swiss Passengers Records, ca. 1820 ca. 1912




- Find Norwegian baptism for Hans whose father was Jorgen. He was born in 1855 in Ringsaker hedmarken
- check Kildeinformasjon: Hedmark fylke,
 Ringsaker, Klokkerbok nr. 6
- add mother kjerstie
- Show Norwegian 1856 Ringsaker hedmarken baptisms for Hans whose father's first name was Jorgen.
